All presenters at EMDRIA Conferences and EMDRIA Virtual Summits must submit both a full **bibliography** and this **citation form** indicating the three (3) most relevant citations for your presentation. Please follow the instructions below to ensure your materials are approved without delay.

### Instructions

Use the steps below to complete the citations form section of this document.

#### a. Review your presentation materials

- Re-read your learning objectives and presentation description
- Identify the core concepts your session covers

#### b. Prepare APA-style bibliography

- Include sources that provide direct relevance to your presentation
- Format your sources according to the most recent APA edition
- Provide the full citation, not a URL alone
- Ensure accuracy—incorrect APA format may delay approval

#### c. Choose three (3) core articles to include on the Citation Form

Select three journal articles that:

- Directly map onto your objectives and content
- Are from a peer-reviewed *journal* (textbooks and book chapters are *not* deemed peer-reviewed)
- Were published within the last 10 years (ideally the past 5 years)
- Enter these 3 citations on the form below
